In December 2018, she had Gamma Knife radiation on her brain to decrease the lesions. The lesions came back in October 2019. An MRI showed swelling around her lesions which increases the pressure in her brain. Her current treatments are designed to decrease the swelling and get the cancer back under control.

Pat's focus is on her children, fighting this horrible disease and maintaining a positive attitude. Unfortunately, Pat's health has declined and it breaks her heart not to be able to work at her store, Hill's Country Store AKA the Purple Store. Her children, Alexa and Tyler, have stepped up and run the store as well as Alexa has a bakery, Alexa's Sweets & Treats, within the store.

Pat has always been a very active part of her community. She served as the Kaneville Village President from May 2013 - May 2017 and as a Village Trustee for many years before her term as the "Mayor". She volunteers with the Lions Club, at her church, local schools and at countless community events. She has set the bar high on giving to her community and this is our time to give back to Pat and her family.
